## Class Supply List

**Pre-class Prep Work:** An email with VERY specific instructions for preparing for the first class will be sent to you before class. Please make sure we have your current email address when you register for class so that we can get this information to you. Please complete the preparation BEFORE class so that you can complete your project by the end of the second class—your time in class will go more smoothly if you are prepared!

- **Sewing machine in good working condition** (please let us know when you register for class if you would like to use one of our machines). If you do not have a BERNINA you can still join us for class—these designs are multi-format and will work with most embroidery machines—however, you must be familiar with how your embroidery machine works.
- **Tool Tote pattern\*** from Quilts Illustrated (#ps054) designed by Penny Sturges (each student is required to bring their own, original copy to class). The pattern also includes the metal stays which are needed. If you already own the pattern you may purchase the metal stays as a “refill” separately.
- **Fabric A:**\* 1/2 yard for outer end pockets, handle, outer bag front and back
- **Fabric B:**\* 1 yard for outer bag ends, inner bag ends, outer bag front and back pockets, inner bag front and back
- **Fabric C:**\* 3/4 yard for inner end pockets, inner front and back pockets, outer bag end pocket linings, outer bag front and back pocket linings
- **PFF:**\* 1/2 yard Thermolam fusible fleece
- **Foam:**\* 1 yard of single sided fusible foam (Bosal In-R-Form)
- **Peltex:**\* 1/3 yard
- **Zipper\*:** one purse zipper that is at least 24” or longer (you may cut it if it is longer than 24”) **You do NOT need a separating zipper as indicated on the pattern.**
- **Thread\*:** to piece bag together and for topstitching—you may want a contrasting color to your fabric for topstitching
- **Zipper foot\*:** if you have a BERNINA, the #4 or #4D foot
- **Patchwork piecing / 1/4” piecing foot\*:** if you have a BERNINA, the #37, #37D, #57, #57D, #97 or #97D foot
- **Edgestitch foot\*:** if you have a BERNINA, the #10 or #10D foot
- **Overcast foot\*:** if you have a BERNINA, the #2 foot
- **Dual feed foot\*:** if you have dual feed on your machine, the dual feed feet are very helpful for this project
- **Basic sewing and embroidery supplies\*:** scissors, pins, sewing machine needles, seam ripper, tape measure, extra bobbins, etc.—your favorite sewing and embroidery supplies. The Frixion pen is perfect for marking on this project and the Wonder Clips from Clover (15 to 20 if you have them) are VERY helpful.

Items marked with an asterisk (\*) are regularly available in our store(s). If there is something we are out of or don’t normally stock but that you need for this class, please ask us—we are happy to do a special order for you! Please remember special orders can take some time so let us know well in advance of class day. Please mark or tag all your tools with your name so that if they are left at the store after class we can return them to you!
